

Mardi Gras in New Orleans is an annual explosion of tumultuous celebration. It began among the French Creoles of New Orleans, and after the Civil War developed into a city-wide event with the visit of the Russian Grand Duke Alexis in 1870. Robert Tallant (1909-1957) was one of Louisiana's best-known authors, and participated in the WPA Writers Project during the 1930s and 1940s. Besides *Mardi Gras ... As It Was*, Tallant also wrote *Voodoo in New Orleans* and *The Voodoo Queen*. With Lyle Saxon and Edward Dreyer he co-authored the famous collection *Gumbo Ya-Ya*.
